



# Person-Centred Dementia Care



## Module code: NS466

Person-centred knowledge and skills for care provision from early to advanced stages of dementia across care settings.

### Who should apply:

Nurses or health and social care practitioners interested in improving their own skills in dementia care and the life of the people they work with. Students must be working in regular contact with people with dementia and willing to take on the role of Dementia Champion within their own organisation.

### Content and structure:

The module will provide the student with the knowledge and skills to manage the care of individuals with dementia and their family/carers. It covers the spectrum of dementia from early to advanced stages of the condition and is relevant to those working in the community,

acute care and long-term care and are in regular contact with people with dementia and their families/carers.

This stand-alone module delivered over a 12-week semester combines attendance at DCU (7 classes) and online learning activities. Assessment is carried out through continuous assessment.
